Comment:The proposed building is too tall; has an aggressively modernist roofline, unsympathetic in both shape and materials to the Jericho conservation area, whose value lies in an organic collection of mainly modest, vernacular-style dwellings; will be damaging to the visual horizon to the north of Worcester College, which should be protected as a matter of public interest; and at the time of the exhibition I visited on 31 January, there were no satisfactory arrangements for bikes coming and going (in theory, they would have to follow the one-way system via Richmond Rd to get on to Walton St, which would be a nuisance to Richmond Rd; but in practice, many would no doubt go the wrong way up Worcester Place, which would be a safety hazard).
