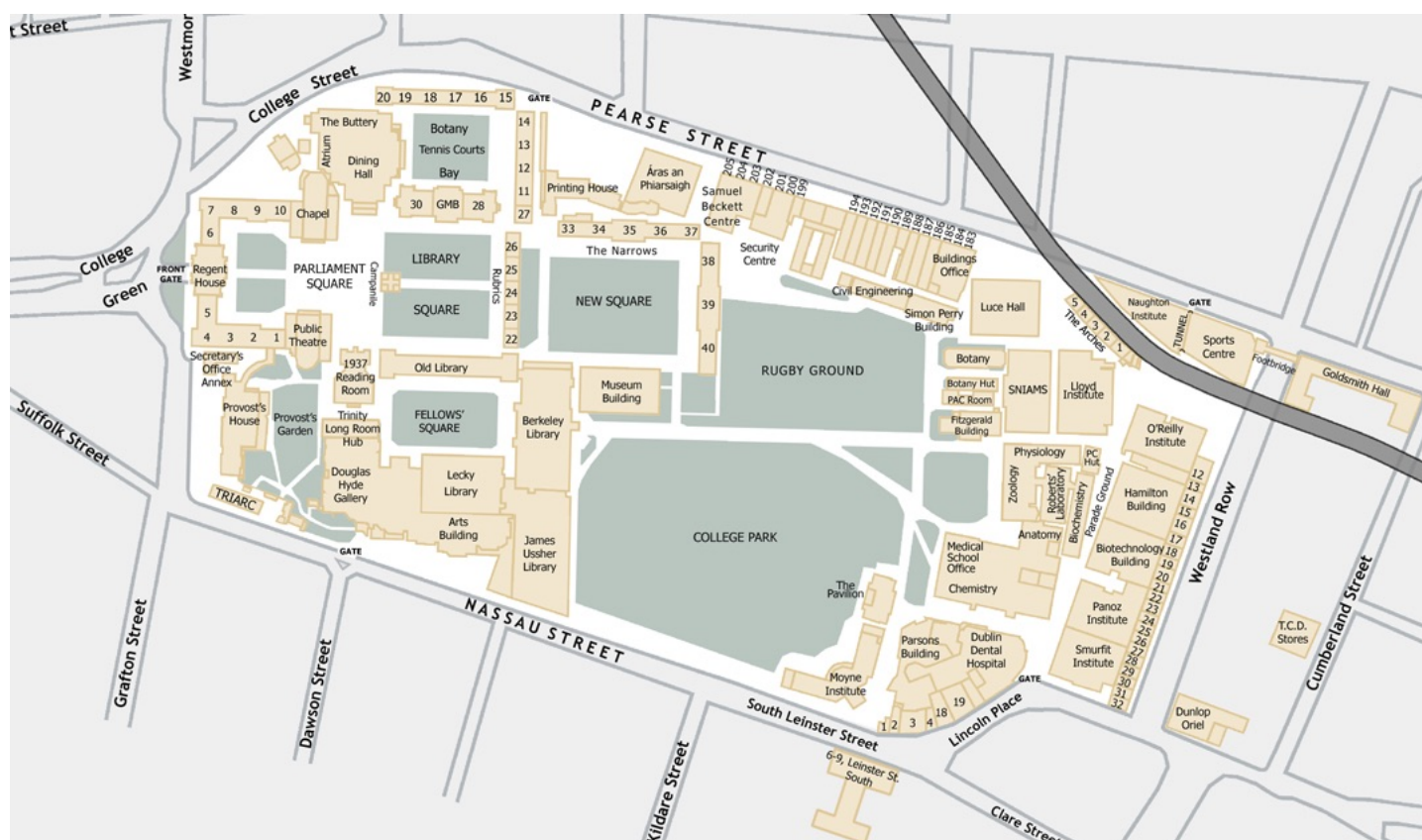


# Practical Information

## Accommodation

- Upon arrival at Trinity College Dublin, please go to the Accommodation Office in **House 10** near the **Front Gate** to pick up your keys. Please be aware that it is open **7.30am - midnight** only.
- If you happen to arrive at Trinity College between 6pm and midnight on Sunday night (28th July), you should instead enter the College through the side gate on Nassau Street (opposite Dawson Street), and proceed to the Accommodation Office, which is open until midnight — because Front Gate is closed between 6pm and midnight.
- The majority of participants are staying in the accommodation block at **47-52 Pearse Street**, which is located on campus next to the **Samuel Beckett Centre**, but unfortunately *isn't* shown on the map above.
- Family apartments are in Houses 33 and 38 around New Square on Campus.
- Guest rooms are in Houses 23 and 40 around New Square on Campus.
- Breakfast is served 7.30am-10am on Campus in **The Buttery**.
- The side gate entrance (shown on the map) next to the **Sports Centre** is convenient for access to Campus from 47-52 Pearse Street, and it is open at reasonable hours.

## Lectures

- All talks will take place in the **Maxwell Theatre** which is in the **Hamilton Building**.
